

## **CHIROUBLES**

## 2021

These are the highest vineyards in Beaujolais, with slopes often exceeding 30%. This guarantees freshness with the current climate changes. The vineyards are subject to arduous and meticulous work. The wine is notable for its smoky woody nose, along with intense cherry aromas. The mouth feel is round and greedy with an elegant acidity. A wine with a distinctive character.

Type: Gamay

Vine pruning: Goblet pruning according to beaujolais tradition.

Average age of the vineyard: 61 years Verbomet, 34 years Châtenay

Vinification: Harvesting and hand sorting

Crate harvesting Destimming 100%

Alternate grape-treading, pump over, and delestage

Cold maceration

Natural fermentation three weeks

Settling ten days

Wild yeasts

Maturation: 50% in oak barrels and 50% in vats for Ten months

Vintage: 2021

Bottling: on the estate

Ageing: Short to average
